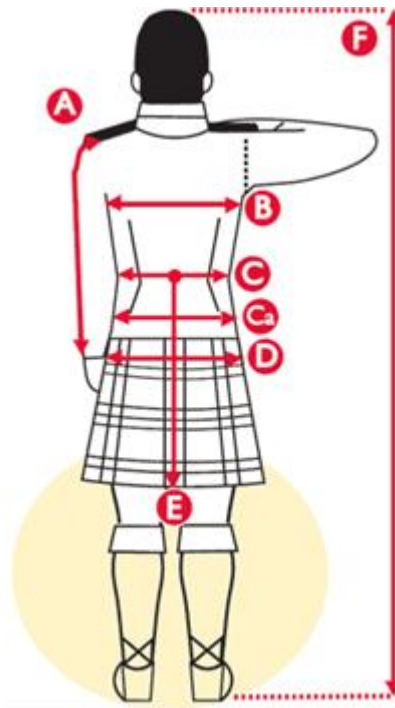


Measuring Guide for Your Bootneck 350 Tartan Kilt



A & B measurements from the diagram are not required for your Kilt.

Please take all measurements in 'inches'.

C: Waist Measurement

- Measure around the waist **at navel height**.
- Take measurement firmly, so that kilt may sit comfortably without falling down.
- Do not breathe in or hold stomach in.

Ca: Inter Measurement (*for Ladies kilts only, not required for men*)

D: Seat Measurement

- Measure around the fullest part of the seat/hips.
- Place three fingers inside the measuring tape, palm down, and flat against your body to avoid getting this measurement too tight.

E: Kilt Length

- You will need assistance with this measurement.
- The helper should measure from **your navel** down to the **half way point across the centre of your knee cap**.
- The best way to do this, is for the wearer to kneel on the floor, with back straight and looking forward.
- While the helper takes the measurement from 'top of navel' (*where the top of the kilt will sit*) 'straight' down to the floor.

F: Height

- We require your overall height in 'feet & inches' to check measurements appear correct.
- Please give your full height from head to foot **without shoes on**.

NB: Assistance with each measurement will ensure better results.

Please double check all your measurements as your kilt will be made to your exact measurements.
